The focus of the conference was building decarbonization strategies. This was especially emphasized as ASHRAE Society President Farooq Mehboob provided updates to the Society's current theme, "Securing Our Future. "The challenge doesn't stop here," Mehboob said. "As an industry, we must remain focused and maintain our position of leadership and preparedness. Our success continues to be based on problem solving, creativity, innovation, flexibility and a willingness to adapt. Our success stems from seeing an opportunity for improvement based on new knowledge and technology."


— Creating the Future! — recognizes how engineers play a vital role in innovating solutions to global challenges that impact future generations. During this week, we make a special effort to reach out


Perhaps you have an interesting story to tell. I would love to hear it.
