The October meeting topic will be "Development and Advances in Liquid Desiccant Technology". The presenter will be Trevor Wende. Mr. Wende is the Vice President of Marketing for Advantix Systems, a manufacturer of innovative energy efficient air conditioning equipment that utilizes liquid desiccant technology. He works with industrial and commercial customers helping them to control humidity and reduce their energy costs by up to 80%.
